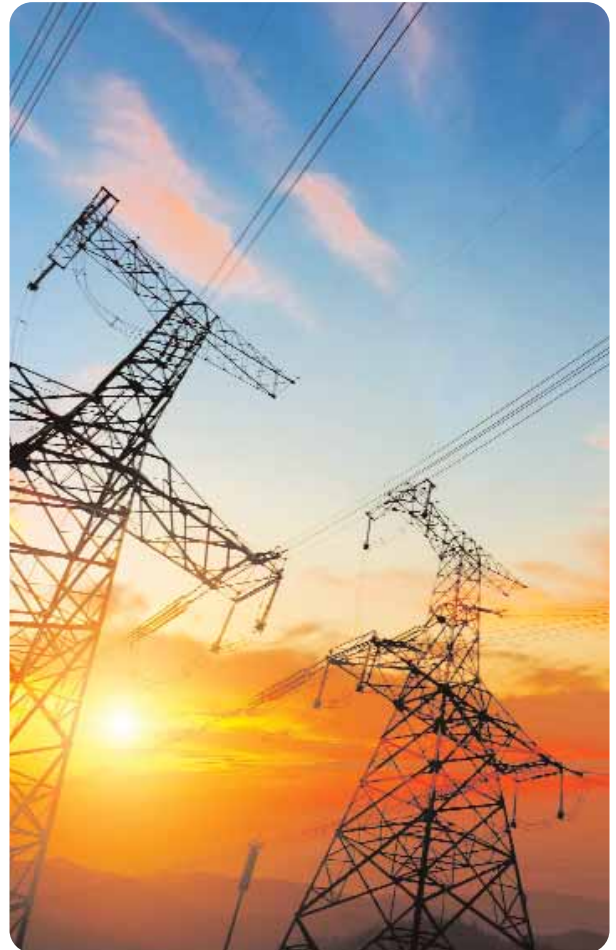
There will be a presentation by the state transco top official, followed by a moderated Q&A with the participants.
